Section 31 provides that the declaration may be quashed by a Court that convicts the person of the relevant offence (at the time of conviction or at a later time). Accordingly the application is to be listed before the Court that has convicted the person of the most recent relevant offence, ie, the offence which gave rise to the declaration as a habitual traffic offender.
