



**LEGAL PROFESSION ADMISSION BOARD
CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF PRACTICAL TRAINING
IN A STATE OTHER THAN NEW SOUTH WALES**

A person who has satisfied the practical training requirements for admission in a State other than New South Wales may be recognised as having satisfied the practical training requirements for admission in New South Wales also. Such a person, in addition to providing the other material required in their application for admission in New South Wales, should provide the following:

- 1) A certificate/letter of completion of practical training course which certifies that the practical legal training course completed by the applicant satisfies the practical training requirements for admission as a Legal Practitioner in their home jurisdiction.

- 2) A letter from the Dean, Dean's delegate or Director of the institution which states that the requirements of the course include evidence of the attainment of competencies in the areas set out in the Sixth Schedule of the *Legal Profession Admission Rules (2005)*.
